

Forest Management Certification ressessment of Open Bay Timber Ltd in East New Britain Province 27 April 2022

Introduction – Preferred by Nature is conducting forest management and chain of custody and controlled wood forest management certification reassessments of the Open Bay Timber Ltd located in East New Britain Province, Papua New Guinea. The reassessment will be implemented from 6 to 9 June 2022. Scope of the Certification Assessment – The forest management certification reassessment will assess the environmental, silvicultural and socioeconomic aspects of the PLANTATIONS managed by Open Bay Timber Ltd, using the FSC-STD-PNG-02-2017 EN V2-0 The FSC National Forest Stewardship Standard of Papua New Guinea; FSC-STD-50-001 V2-0 Requirements for use of the FSC trademarks by certificate holders and FSC-STD-30-010 V2-0 EN Controlled Wood Standard for FM enterprises. PbN is accredited by the Forest Stewardship Council[™] (FSC[™]) and this assessment process must follow procedures which have been approved. Assessment Team Composition – The assessment team will be led by Ms. Malory Weston. The team members will be one qualified local expert.

Assessment Steps and Schedule – The assessment will be conducted using hybrid method. Following is a short description of the certification process and a tentative agenda:

- <u>Assessment organization</u> PbN local espert will arrive in kokopo on 5 June 2022. Lead auditor will lead the assessment remotely throughout the evaluation process.
- <u>Field assessments</u> The team will visit sites managed by Open Bay Timber Ltd from 6 to 9 June 2022.
- <u>Stakeholder consultation</u> Throughout the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders
 regarding Open Bay Timber Ltd forest management in villages surrounding the forest area. This will
 include private interviews and discussions, and public stakeholder meetings.
- <u>Final assessment briefing</u> Prior to departure the team will meet with Open Bay Timber Ltd managers and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- <u>Draft report production</u> The assessment team will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to Open Bay Timber Ltd. This should occur 30 days after completion of the assessment.
- <u>Certification decision</u> Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from Open Bay Timber Ltd forest managers and other general stakeholder comments, PbN will reach a certification decision. Barring unforeseen obstacles, this should occur by 9 August 2022.

Your Input Sought – As a part of the forest certification assessment process we invite stakeholders to offer comment and feedback on Open Bay Timber Ltd forest management in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above as well as comments on the FME's management and protection of High Conservation Values within the forest under evaluation. We welcome input, either public or confidential, in whatever form is easiest and most secure for you. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the reassessment process, but we would prefer to receive your comments either prior to the reassessment, during the reassessment, or prior to 9 July 2022 so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision by 9 August 2022. Your options for communicating your observations to us are as follows.

1. Meet with a PbN reassessment team member during or shortly after the fieldwork.
