Introduction

Preferred by Nature is conducting an FSC® forest management and chain of custody reassessment audit of Eastwood Forests LLC forest management units located in New York and Virginia, USA. The evaluation will be conducted during the week of **June 10-14, 2024**.

Scope of Evaluation

Steps and Schedule

Following is a short description of the evaluation process and a tentative agenda:

- Stakeholder and Indigenous communities/peoples' consultation – Prior and throughout the fieldwork, the team will contact local stakeholders and Indigenous communities/peoples regarding the forest management activities of the certificate holder in communities. This can include private interviews and discussions as well as public meetings.
- Field visits – During **June 10-14**, the audit team will conduct field visits of recent and active forest management operations on the certified area.
- Final evaluation briefing – Prior to departure the team will meet with the certificate holder's forest managers and other parties to finalize their data collection and present preliminary findings.
- Draft report production – The audit team will produce a confidential draft report that will be circulated for comment to the certificate holder. This should occur within one month after completion of the evaluation.
- Certification decision – Upon receipt of comments on the draft report from the certificate holder forest managers, and other general stakeholder and Indigenous communities/peoples' comments, Preferred by Nature will reach a certification decision. Barring unforeseen obstacles, this should occur by end of **August 2024**.

Your Comments Sought

As a part of the audit process, we invite stakeholders and Indigenous communities/peoples to offer comments on the certificate holder's forest management activities in relation to conformance with the requirements of the forest management standard referenced above.

We welcome input, either public or confidential. Your input will be valuable at any stage of the process, but we would prefer to receive your comments before the end of the on-site audit so that we can take them into consideration in reaching a certification decision. Your options for communicating your comments are as follows:

1. Speak with a Preferred by Nature audit team member before or during the audit.
2. Send comments to the Preferred by Nature staff person responsible for coordinating this audit (see contact info below)
