NEPCon (Nature Economy and People Connected) is an international non-profit organisation. We have 13 regional offices and 115 staff located across Europe, Russia, Asia, Australia and the U.S.

For over 20 years, we have worked to foster sustainable land use and responsible trade in forest products. We do this through innovative projects, capacity building and sustainability services.

A self-managing division of NEPCon promotes and delivers our sustainability certification services. Surplus from these activities supports the development and implementation of our non-profit projects.

### Choosing solutions that work

Market-based sustainability instruments are only credible if they create positive impacts on the ground. We offer our services under well-recognised schemes, and we focus on providing high-quality services.

We also help develop and improve the systems we work with.

As a subscriber to the ISEAL Alliance, we are committed to creating credible social and environmental standards.

### International collaboration

We work together with other organisations to develop green solutions with maximal impact.

For example, we participate in the development of certification systems such as Forest Stewardship Council™ (FSC™), Sustainable Agriculture Network (SAN) and Sustainable Biomass Partnership (SBP). In addition, we contribute to key global discussions at conferences and meetings around the world.

# What we do

## Initiatives that foster change

We engage in projects that develop new green solutions, conserve biodiversity or help buyers to make sustainable choices.

Our main focus is on overcoming barriers to sustainable development. For example, we develop toolkits and courses for small and medium-sized enterprises, supporting these organisations in taking responsible approaches despite their limited resources.

Our projects are funded by donors, governments and companies and have supported the establishment of over 100 protected areas. We make our risk assessments, tools and other information freely available. To date, we have evaluated forest legality in 70 countries.

## Capacity building

Knowledge and skills are key to sustainable development. Thousands of delegates from over 30 countries have joined training events where our experts share their insights.

## Tailored sustainability services

We offer bespoke services that draw on our expertise. This includes analyses, strategic development and capacity building. Our customers are companies, government agencies, NGOs and investors.

## Timber certification

We provide FSC certification to more than 1500 certified companies and 31 million hectares of FSC-certified forests. In addition, we offer PEFC Chain of Custody (CoC) and generic CoC certification as well as forest contractor certification. We also provide related training and information.

## Timber legality services

Our LegalSource™ Programme is designed for organisations sourcing and supplying legal timber products. It is particularly useful for companies importing timber products into regulated markets such as the EU, the U.S. and Australia - and for companies that supply these markets.

## Responsible biomass

We provide SBP certification to energy producers who want to ensure that their woody biomass is both sourced responsibly and has known climate credentials. We assess the risks associated with sourcing biomass feedstocks for several European countries.

## Climate change

Our Carbon Footprint Management Standard helps our clients measure and reduce their carbon emissions year on year. Our forest carbon verification services include projects on reforestation, avoided deforestation and improved forest management.

## Sustainable agriculture supply chains

We offer Chain of Custody certification according to the SAN / Rainforest Alliance standards to processors and traders of agricultural products such as tea, coffee, bananas and chocolate.
